Summer High School Internship: **Paid 10 week summer program**, only open to Puget Sound students. High School Interns will be working with engineering teams on interesting technical problems. You will have the opportunity to contribute meaningful work and be supported by a mentor throughout the summer.

High School Bootcamp: The Microsoft Bootcamp is a **3-day summer program at Microsoft** focused on creating an enriching environment for local students who want exposure to the field of software engineering. The program provides challenging but achievable projects that will encourage juniors and seniors to continue in STEM fields.

Qualifications:

- High School juniors or seniors in the Puget Sound, Washington region.
- Have demonstrated an interest in technology.
- Have a basic grasp of HTML, Visual Basic, or other programming language.
- Be at least 16 years old and have a legal right to work in the US for the duration of the internship (not required for the High School Bootcamp)
- Be available to work full time, 40 hours per week, for 10 consecutive weeks starting in June. Or be able to attend all 3 days of Bootcamp (Date TBD)
- Have not been hired as a Microsoft High School Intern previously

All Puget Sound-area high school students are welcome to apply. We especially encourage applications from under represented populations (African American, Native American, and Hispanic), young women, individuals with disabilities and students from economically disadvantaged families.
